WHAT'S NEW? WORK PACKAGE 4

Capacity-Building

Between April and September 2024, project partners delivered some capacity-building activities for adult trainers, school staff and cultural mediators. The purpose of these activities was to equip participants with the necessary skills to act as mediators for migrants' inclusion, by focusing on their upskilling and knowledge sharing. Participants had the chance to become familiar with the Toolkit and Curriculum on topics related to migrant students' social inclusion (inclusive education, community engagement, mental well-being, cultural mediation), both developed throughout the Inclusive Hubs project lifecycle.



In parallel with the realisation of the capacity-building activities, project partners initiated an implementation program involving one primary school in each partner country.
